



## SITUATION

*USS Blueforce* (DZ 204) (aka *Acoustic Explorer*) requests immediate hull survey @ SPAWAR Systems Center San Diego. Suspicious swimmer activity reported this a.m. No known or immediate threat of hostile action. *Blueforce* has a sail time of 17:30. We have a 2.5 hour window of survey to accommodate ship's schedule. EOD is on standby.

## MISSION

- **Primary**  
100% coverage of hull using sonar and visual, marking any targets of interest with the ship hull system.
- **Secondary, Red Team**  
Visually inspect pilings and fender system.
- **Secondary, Blue Team**  
Reorient search to check for any target on ocean bottom.

## EXECUTION

- Blue team will launch off the port side, find a safe entry point, scan and note approximate location of any TOIs
- Red team will launch off the stern, find a safe entry point and clear the running gear. Once running gear has been cleared, we'll move into marking any TOIs the blue team found.
- Video will be running at all times; still pictures of TOIs will be captured as well.

## ACTIONABLE ITEM

- When first target is reported, both ROVs will back off to a safe location until "Z" is set and all DC parties are ready to go.
- Once confirmed, TOI is identified. Again we'll wait for the CO's permission to continue the mission.

## CONCLUSION

Upon completion of mission, equipment will be cleaned, operation test performed and equipment stowed.
